

NADMAS Temporary-covid-19-flying-site-rules

Rules effective from 17 May 2021

1. All members / visitors should not be at the flying site without having booked in their Name and valid e-mail address, on the NADMAS appointment page. <https://nadmabmfa.org/booking-form>
2. If more than one person from the same household are attending, names are required. Spectators and non-participants should be kept to a minimum.
3. A maximum of 3 persons are permitted in the Pilot box and **Maximum of 3 aircraft** flying at any one time. Social distancing should be maintained at all-times.
4. If training is taking place the number of persons in the vicinity of the pilot box may be increased to 5 with a maximum of 3 Aircraft flying. Instructor observing appropriate social distancing from their pupil and other pilots.
5. Numbers can be increased to 4 model aircraft in the Air if a drone or helicopter is flying on a separate part of the field, In accordance to NADMAS rules 21.1. Social distancing should be maintained at all-times.
6. Cars should be parked in the same way, i.e., all facing forward so everyone is accessing their cars from the right-hand door.
7. Members to remind Non-members of rules.

Clarifications.

NADMAS must follow the current guidance and put in place measurements to protect members / visitors.

- Track and Trace, (Booking Form)
- Risk Assessment.

If more than one person from the same household is attending the flying site, a separate booking of each person is **not required**, just the names on the same booking form. i.e. Tom, Jerry, Tweety pie.

NADMAS must keep records for a minimum of 21 days, who has visited the site.

Appropriate hand sanitizer (>60% Alcohol Content) and latex gloves is to be carried and used by members where appropriate.

Your support and understanding are most appreciated. Please be respectful and courteous if you are asking or asked to move away.

Appropriate Social Distancing is always to be observed.
